
The attention of the Registrars is invited to the subject cited and they are informed that, in order to reinforce the importance of maintaining a drug-free environment in all educational institutions across the State, and in pursuance of the resolutions issued vide reference cited, the following measures shall be implemented from the Academic Year 2026-27 in all Government/Private Aided/Private Un-aided/ University Constituent colleges across the State.

All Registrars are informed to issue necessary instructions to all Government/Private Aided/Private Un-aided/University Constituent colleges under your administrative control to ensure that, in respect of students where admissions are made through online portals, a declaration from students in respect of drug abuse, as appended to the memo in Annexure I is obtained online, at the time of admission. In respect of admissions made through physical mode also, the declaration shall be obtained in writing from each student in the format appended to this memo in Annexure I. It shall be ensured that all students admitted into the institutions submit such declaration without fail.

The Heads of Institutions of Government/Private Aided/Private Un-aided/University Constituent colleges also, shall furnish a declaration in the prescribed format as appended to this memo in Annexure II, affirming that the campus is maintained in a drug-free environment and that necessary preventive and awareness measures will be implemented, to the affiliating universities. Further, all such Drug-Free Campus Declarations shall be hosted on the official websites of the respective Higher Education Institutions.

It shall further be ensured that all students, of all years, admitted into all courses of the institution, take declaration as an oath, on the first day of the academic year.

The Registrars shall closely monitor the implementation of the above instructions and ensure strict compliance by all concerned.

ANTI-DRUG AFFIDAVIT (For Students against Drug Use and Possession in Telangana)

Declaration

I, the undersigned, hereby solemnly affirm and declare as follows:

1. I am aware of the UGC regulations, on curbing the menace of drug abuse in Higher Educational institutions, I carefully read and fully understood the provisions contained in the said Regulations.
2. I am aware that the possession, use, sale and distribution of alcohol/tobacco/ any psychoactive substances are wrong and harmful. I acknowledge that consumption, possession, or trafficking of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances is a criminal offence under the NDPS Act, 1985, punishable with rigorous imprisonment and fine.
3. I am aware that ignorance of Law is no excuse, in the eyes of law. I am aware of the provisions of the NDPS Act, 1985 and other acts preventing the abuse or possession of drugs. I will also update myself with the various laws, regulations, orders etc. issued by the concerned authorities and Government from time to time.
4. I shall refrain from using, being under the influence of, possessing, furnishing, distributing, selling or conspiring to sell or possess, or being in the chain of sale or distribution of alcohol/ tobacco/ any psychoactive substances within/outside the premises of the institute/ university or during any sponsored activities by the institute /university.
5. I shall report to the authorities of the institution any irregular behaviour that I observe in relation to the possession, use, sale and distribution of alcohol/ tobacco/any psychoactive substances which may have occurred at/outside the institution or during any activities conducted by any students or institution.
6. I shall support and actively participate in any education programmes which may be organized regarding prevention of substance use by the institution / government which would enable me to be a better student and citizen of India.
7. I shall cooperate with the authorities of the institution and other relevant authorities in their investigation of any substance-related incident of which I may have information, and to prevent the possession, use, sale and distribution of any psychoactive substances in or around or outside my institution. I shall cooperate with Anti-Drug Committees and awareness programs conducted in my institution.

8. I shall participate in half-yearly/yearly medical check-up organized by the institution. This medical check-up may include screening for drug abuse.
9. In case my name appears as an accused in any case regarding the abuse of NDPS drugs, my parents or guardians will be informed and the college administration will take me for drug screening to a government approved facility.
10. If drug screening test results as positive, I will be referred for counselling, rehabilitation and recovery to a government de-addiction facility.
11. If I am found in possession of drugs or consuming drugs or encouraging others to consume drugs or involving in drug related activities in the institution, strict disciplinary and legal action may be taken against me.

Consequences of Violation

12. I understand that violation of this undertaking will result in disciplinary action, including suspension, expulsion, or cancellation of admission by the institution.
13. I am aware that in addition to the above, the legal prosecution under the NDPS Act and relevant Government Orders will follow any violation.
14. I declare that my parents/ guardians are aware of this undertaking and support my compliance with anti-drug laws and institutional policies.
