Sub: SATAVAHANA UNIVERSITY, KARIMNAGAR – Maintenance of Drug-Free Environment in Educational Institutions – Implementation of Anti-Drug Measures and Submission of Declarations by Students and Institutions – Instructions – Issued – Reg.

Ref: Proceedings of the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Telangana, Hyderabad, CCE-AC/DOST/2/2026-Academic Cell, dated 09.06.2026.

All the Correspondents/Principals of University Colleges, Constituent Colleges and Affiliated Colleges under the jurisdiction of the University are hereby informed that the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Telangana, has issued instructions for strengthening and maintaining a **Drug-Free Environment in Educational Institutions**.

In compliance with the above instructions, all the colleges are hereby directed to implement the following measures with immediate effect:

1. Student Anti-Drug Declaration:

Every student admitted into the institution shall submit an **Anti-Drug Affidavit/Declaration** in the prescribed format (Annexure-I). In respect of admissions made through online mode, the declaration shall be obtained online, and for admissions made through physical mode, the declaration shall be obtained in writing and maintained in the college records.

2. Institutional Drug-Free Campus Declaration:

The Correspondent/Principal of each institution shall submit a **Drug-Free Campus Declaration** in the prescribed format (Annexure-II), affirming that the institution maintains a drug-free environment and undertakes necessary preventive and awareness measures.

3. Awareness and Preventive Measures:

Colleges shall organize regular awareness programmes, counselling sessions, student meetings, parent interactions, college assemblies and other suitable activities to educate students on the harmful effects of drug abuse and substance abuse.

4. Monitoring and Vigilance:

Institutions shall maintain strict vigilance within and around the campus and promptly report any suspected cases of drug abuse, possession, peddling or related activities to the competent authorities as per the rules in force.

5. Student Oath:

It shall be ensured that all students, irrespective of the year of study, take the anti-drug declaration/oath on the first day of the academic year.

6. Website Hosting:

The Drug-Free Campus Declaration submitted by the institution shall be displayed on the official website of the respective college.

All the Correspondents/Principals are requested to ensure strict compliance with the above instructions and submit the **Institutional Drug-Free Campus Declaration (Annexure-II)** duly signed and sealed to the University/undersigned on or before **04-07-2026**.
